Kerbing works to protect the grass verge and alleviate carriageway flooding issues in that area. What are we doing?

We will be closing the road and carrying out double height kerbing works to prevent encroachment of vehicles onto the grass verge and some carriageway patching to stop water ponding on the carriageway

Dates & Times

The work is programmed to start on Monday 21st November, and should be completed within 10 days. We will be working between the hours of 09.30 to 15.00.

How will this affect you?

We will endeavour to maintain access to properties or businesses, however, this may not be possible at all times and there may be a slight delay in obtaining access during specific works operations. Access for Emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Do not park in the works area during the publicised dates and times. If parked vehicles are holding up the works and we cannot contact the owner, we have the legal right to move and relocate them to a nearby street.

What are we asking you to do?

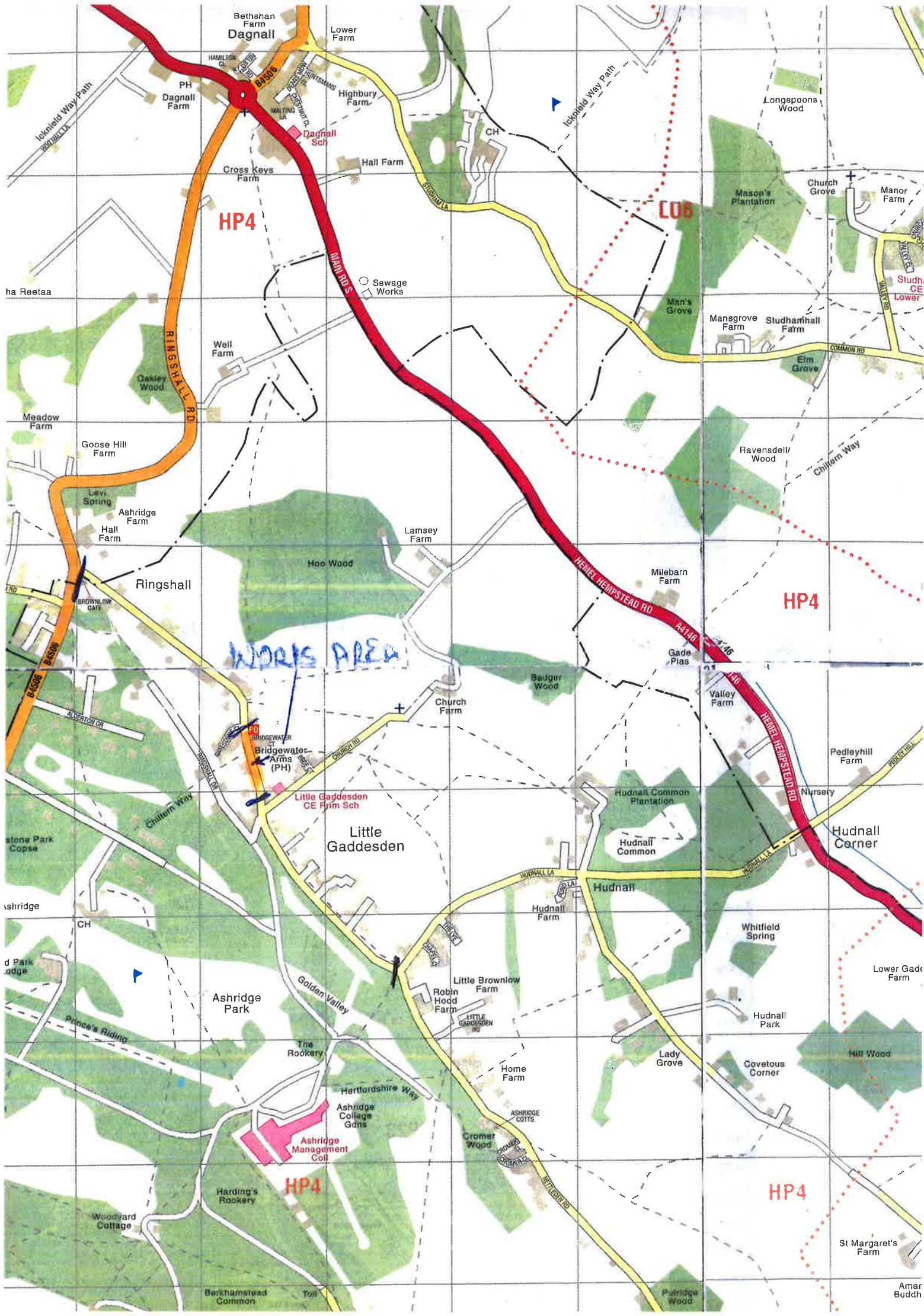
Please make sure that you move your car out of the works area before the works starts.
